- The show is open to any Butler County 4-H Member (including Cloverbuds).
- Participants must arrive by 11 AM to pick up their participant number.
- Talents may include, but are not limited to, singing, dancing, instrumental music, skits, magic, comedy, martial arts, juggling. Unique acts are always appreciated!
- Participants must return a completed Talent Show Participation Form and signed Waiver of Liability form (back of book) by July 14 to the Farm Show Office.
- Recommended length is 2 to 3 minutes; acts must not be longer than 3 minutes.
- Absolutely no profanity or insensitive subject matter or songs will be permitted.
- Participants are responsible for their own props and costumes. Costumes must be appropriate for all age groups.
- If the act requires recorded accompanying music, the music must be provided to Cara Stephenson prior to August 1 and must be labeled with the participant's name and song name. It is the participant's responsibility to get the recorded music back after the show.

All performers will receive a prize.
